“Uniforms Re-loved” is UMS’s commitment to reducing our environmental impact. This initiative emphasises reusing, refurbishing, and recycling materials and products for as long as possible. By extending the life cycle of products, we reduce waste and environmental impact.

Here's how you can help:

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**1. Collect and Drop Off**  
Drop off any pre-loved school uniforms to your UMS Uniform Shop. Damaged or not, all are welcome. \*Please wash them before dropping off.
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**2. Sorting for Sustainability**  
We sort each item into two categories: “Re-love” for those that can be worn again, and “Recycle” for those that cannot.
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**3. Re-love and Reuse**  
Garments in the “Re-love” category are given new life and sent to UMSV, where they are donated to local orphanages or pagodas in Vung Tau, Vietnam.
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**4. Recycle and Repurpose**  
“Recycle” garments are transformed by our recycling partner into useful commodities. Where textiles are not fit for wear, they begin the recycling process. Most commonly, they turn textiles into revolutionary material, UPtex, which can be used for packaging, signage, homewares, and more!
